





<p>Sentences</p> <p>Write <u>at least 10</u> of your spelling words in sentences that show <u>you know the meaning of the word</u>. Underline the spelling words.</p>	<p>Shape Write</p> <p>at least ten of your words. Draw tall boxes for tall letters, small boxes for small letters and boxes that hang below the line for letters that do also. Fill in the boxes with your words.</p>	<p>Dictionary Use:</p> <p>Look up ten of your spelling words in the dictionary. Write the guide words at the top of the dictionary page that go with each word.</p>	<p>Reverse ABC...</p> <p>Write your words in reverse ABC order.</p> 	<p>What if?</p> <p>Create five "what if" questions. Example: What if we went to <u>school</u> on Saturdays?</p>
<p>Color Code</p> <p>Write or type your spelling words. Use <u>blue</u> for the consonants and <u>red</u> for the vowels.</p>	<p>Rule Writing:</p> <p>if you were in charge of your house, school, state or country for one day, what rules would you make? Create a list of rules using at least 10 spelling words.</p>	<p>Just Write Them!</p> <p>Number your paper 1-20 and write your words!</p>	<p>Write a friendly letter (to anyone) using at least <u>10</u> of your spelling words.</p> 	<p>Draw a picture, include background and detail. <p>Poem</p> <p>Use <u>at least 5</u> of your spelling words to create a poem.</p>	<p>Lost and Found:</p> <p>Write one lost and one found advertisement. Use five spelling words in each one. Ex. Lost - A tortoise shell kitten wearing an orange collar. Answers to the name <u>Daisy</u>. Found on the corner of <u>Nebraska</u> and <u>Maryland</u>.</p>	<p>Free Space</p> <p>Select your own creative idea using 10 spelling words. Create your own Activity.</p>	<p>Create a "to-do" list using at least 10 of your spelling words. Ex. 1. Wash the <u>automobile</u>.</p> 	<p>Triangle Writing</p> <p>Select your five hardest words. Practice writing them, adding one letter at a time. Ex. n No Not Note</p>
<p>Puzzle</p> <p>Make a crossword puzzle or word search using all of your spelling words.</p> 	<p>Word Sort</p> <p>Sort your words into categories. You decide what the categories are.</p>	<p>ABC Order...</p> <p>Write or type your words in ABC order.</p> 	<p>Rainbow Write</p> <p>Look at the first letter in your spelling words. Follow the guide below and write your words in their color. A-F= Red, J-L= Orange, M-P= Blue, Q-T= Green, U-Z= Purple</p>	<p>Encryption</p> <p>Create a code for your spelling words.
